JOB DESCRIPTION

RADIUS is looking for a BC-based 'network weaver' to join our team. The Weaver will be primarily responsible for convening regional gatherings and learning events, strategic inquiry into regional priority areas, and contributing to the SI Canada national network.

Responsibilities:

- Coordinates, plans and facilitates BC Changing Systems Group quarterly gatherings
- Participates in a minimum of one SI Canada Community of Practice (CoP)
- Participates in monthly strategic learning calls with SI Canada weaver group
- Supports strategy development and fundraising efforts for growing SI Canada presence and impact throughout BC
- Contributes to planning SI Canada national conference in May 2020
- Acts as an ambassador of SI Canada at local and regional events
- Identifies new opportunities for issue based CoPs from the region, lead needs assessment and proposes recommended support strategies
- Leads stakeholder mapping as required by SI Canada national
- Ensures integration and coordination of SI Canada work with RADIUS team and Hub, and other BC-based Weavers
